The Republic of Turkey has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD), European Investment Bank (EIB), Council of Europe Development Bank (CEB) and Islamic Development Bank (IDB) to finance the Istanbul Seismic Risk Mitigation and Emergency Preparedness Project and recently has received a loan from the Council of Europe Development Bank (CEB) for the amount of EUR 250 million in addition to the Loan signed on September 16, 2010 (loan number F/P 1701 (2010), amounting to EUR 250 m) for a continuous support of the Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds of these loans to payments under the contracts for Procurement of "Consultancy Services for Design of Hospitals (AF-CEB-CB1.4A)", which will be implemented by Istanbul Project Coordination Unit.

2. The award procedure chosen: Restricted Procedure

3. Form of the contract: Public Procurement of Services

4. Place of execution/performance of the works, for delivery of products or of the provision of services:

• Haydarpaşa Numune Training and Research Hospital

and

• Dr. Siyami Ersek Chest and Cardiovascular Training and Research Hospital

are located at the same plot and near side of the main Highway in Anatolian side of İstanbul.

5. Category and Description of Services:

Both hospitals are one of the largest healthcare service providers in terms of bed capacities and provided inpatient days. Besides, they also provide services for a highly significant number of outpatients. Haydarpaşa Numune Training and Research Hospital is a general hospital but it also has a major function as onchology. The new buildings are planned to be constructed within the existing hospital complex having a land of approximately 82.000 m2. However, some of the existing buildings are out of the design scope, since Administration buildings are registered as historical structure and Ophthalmology, Main Cardiovascular Building and Outpatient Clinic are constructed in recent decade. For these reasons, maintaining the uninterrupted operability of the hospital services and also integration of the existing building with new buildings should be taken into account during design stages.

It is envisaged that;

- Design of Haydarpaşa Numune Training and Research Hospital will have approximately 800 beds capacity.
- Design of Siyami Ersek Chest and Cardiovascular_Training and Research Hospital will have approximately 200 beds capacity.

The design of the hospital buildings shall be <u>in accordance with</u> Healthcare Building Standards and Codes of the Ministry of Health and shall meet the technical requirements and the specific functions of the units as well as <u>the international standards and applicable EU</u> <u>Legislation.</u>

In order to provide the uninterrupted services during and after a potential earthquake, the hospital will be designed with seismic isolation devices (base isolation).

Both hospitals shall be designed <u>according to green building concept</u> by concerning the international standards and codes. Projects shall be finalized for <u>green building certification</u>.

Design services will be executed with <u>BIM (Building Information Model)</u> according to the ISO 29481-1:2010 "Building information modeling - Information delivery manual - Part 1: Methodology and format", ISO 16739:2013 "Industry Foundation Classes (IFC) for data sharing in the construction and facility management industries" and other relevant codes. Scope of the services is included but not limited to as follows:

a. Operational planning, Medical planning, preparation of concept design, architectural drawings for the hospital buildings along with alternative architectural layouts to meet site conditions, functional and beneficiary needs.

b. Investigation of site specific soil parameters, requirements of geo-technical surveys and data collection studies for the site to examine the soil conditions for the hospital buildings to be constructed.

c. Preparation of all related construction drawings considering technical requirements, applicable local and international standards (structural, architectural, mechanical, electrical, electronics and communication, infrastructural and landscaping drawings etc) in compliance with new Turkish Earthquake Code ensuring the seismic resistance of both the structural and nonstructural components of the hospital buildings in the case of a seismic event will occur in Istanbul.

d. Preparation of all necessary tender documents, technical specifications, cost estimation and Bill of Quantities etc. with respect to final construction drawings.

6. If the contracts are subdivided into lots, indication of the possibility of tendering for one, for several or for all the lots:

Consultancy Services for Design of Hospitals (AF-CEB-CB1.4A) will be tendered under one lot.

7. Number of short-lists:

One shortlist group will be formed within the interested consultants in accordance with their qualifications and experience.

8. Completion date or duration of the service contracts:

The estimated timetable for completion of the services including design is approximately **12 months.**

9. Admission or prohibition of variants: Submission of alternative proposals is not accepted.

10. Special conditions for fulfilling the contract: Not Applicable.

14. Where applicable, the legal form to be taken by the grouping of economic operators to whom the contract is to be Awarded:

Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications. The "association" may take the form of a Joint Venture or a sub consultancy. In case of a Joint Venture (JV), all members of the JV will be evaluated jointly for the purpose of short listing and shall be jointly and severally liable for the assignment and shall sign the contract in case award is made to that JV group. Interested consultants should clearly indicate the structure of their "association" and the duties of the partners and sub consultants in their application. <u>Consultants may associate with specific sub-consultants in green building certification and also Consultants may associate with specific sub-consultants in base isolation design if they dont have such experiences by their own. Such subconsultants may associate with more than one consultant. Unclear expression of interests in terms of "in association with" and/or "in affiliation with", etc. may not be considered for short listing. Joint Venture agreement to be authenticated in case of Contract Award.</u>
