Consultancy Services for Revision of the Projects for Okmeydani Training and Research Hospital Phase-II (KfW-CB1.5)

Republic of Turkey has received a loan from **German Development Bank (KfW)** toward the cost of Istanbul Seismic Risk Mitigation and Emergency Preparedness Project (ISMEP) and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds to eligible payments under “**Consultancy Services for Revision of the Projects for Okmeydani Training and Research Hospital Phase-II (KfW-CB1.5)**” which will be implemented by Republic of Turkey, Istanbul Governorship Istanbul Project Coordination Unit (PCU).

The objective of the consulting services is (not limited) to conduct preparation of shoring system design, revision of the projects in accordance with the latest regulations, reporting, LEED certificating services, preparation of tender documents for Okmeydani Training and Research Hospital Phase-II.

The duration of services is envisaged as **90 calendar days** after contract signing.

Istanbul Project Coordination Unit now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must provide information and documents indicating that they are qualified to perform the services such as (not limited to);

- The Consultant shall have deep knowledge for several IFIs’ procedures and FIDIC rules.
- The Consultant shall have knowledge for LEED certification.
- The Consultant must have the experience of major similar assignment completed in past ten years for construction design and supervision works in Public Buildings with preference for experience on hospital/health centers.
- The Consultant shall have design experience regarding Shoring System.
- Financial status with consultancy turnover in past five (2015-2019) years.
- Availability of appropriate skills among key personnel, team composition, etc.
- Consultants should provide the below listed information;
 - ✓ Company information,

- ✓ Letters of recommendation from previous Employers,
- ✓ A list of ongoing assignments including the start and end dates and the personnel involved.

Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications. The “association” may take the form of a Joint Venture or a sub consultancy. In case of a Joint Venture (JV), all members of the JV will be evaluated jointly for the purpose of short listing and shall be jointly and severally liable for the assignment and shall sign the contract after tender award. Interested consultants should clearly indicate the structure of their “association” and the duties of the partners and sub consultants in their application. Unclear expression of interests in terms of “in association with” and/or “in affiliation with” and etc. may not be considered for short listing.

Consultants will be shortlisted in accordance with the procedures set out in the World Bank’s *Guidelines: [Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers](#)* (published by the Bank in January 2011 and revised in July 2014) (“Consultant Guidelines”). Interested consultants may obtain further information at the address below from 10:00 a.m. to 16:00 hours, local time.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the Consultant Guidelines, setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Selection Based on the Consultants’ Qualifications (CQS) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.

Consultants are required to include the name and reference number of the tasks (**KfW-CB1.5**) in their Expression of Interests.

Expressions of interest must be delivered to the address below by **24th of April, 2020 | 16:00** (local time) by surface mail, courier or hand delivery. Applications by e-mail shall not be accepted and IPCU reserves the right to reject the applications received after the above-referenced date.
